## **Historic Buckhead House Is Literally 'On The Move'**

Atlanta, GA, June 11, 2008: Ninety-foot steel beams and a network of bracing straps are in place for the dramatic relocation of the 1920's "Buckhead Skylodge" to its new setting in Kalmia View. The historic stone house will be moved on tracks to the edge of the site where it will serve as the centerpiece of the exclusive new project that's at the highest point along the border of the North Buckhead and Brookhaven neighborhoods.

"We're using twice as much steel to move the house in one piece," says James Morehead, president of JTM House Movers. "It will be a challenge because of the rock on the outside, but we've never lost a house yet."

Morehead says his company has moved 250 homes, but this one's unique and will require extra care to gently relocate it 80 feet to a new foundation on the corner of Kalmia View.

JTM House Movers was hired by the Kalmia View development team headed up by Faulk Design and Development, ScenicLand, Howard Design Studio and Summerour & Associates Architects.

"I am really in love with the existing house and excited that it's going to be saved," says Keith Summerour, award winning architect and president of Summerour & Associates. Summerour says the home's clean, European vernacular will serve as the inspiration for three other homes at Kalmia View. He says the project's unique location on the top of a hill is providing some wonderful design opportunities.

"All of these houses have the ability on one side or the other to open to the outside," says Summerour, "so we're using rich materials on the exteriors, walkways and terraces, so that the homes at Kalmia View will be as beautiful on the outside as they are on the inside."
